As these new reprocessing machines will be installed in various countries, Michelin's requirement was for a high performance dust collector that was simple to install and simple to maintain.

The technological innovations and competitive pricing of the Gold Series dust collector convinced Michelin to place an order with Camfil Farr APC rather than their usual suppliers.

The system incorporates a GS02 ATEX dust collector complete with flame quench flameless venting, a control panel and ducting system.

The installation was completed in December 2010 and fully meets the customer's requirements. Camfil Farr APC has now been selected to supply a further 7 systems as the new machines are installed in other factories around the world. The success of the system has also prompted enquiries for more information from other departments within Michelin.


